#### **Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Call to Order: Chair Kara Escajeda called the meeting to order at 9:06 a.m.
- 2. Public Comments: No comments were made from the public.
- 3. Staff Update.

John Weber provided an update on air quality readings throughout the KTMPO Region.

4. Action Item: Regarding approval of March 9, 2016 meeting minutes.

Brian Chandler made a motion to approve March 9, 2016 meeting minutes, Leo Mantey seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

**5. Discussion and Possible Action Item:** Discuss and take appropriate action to appoint additional BPAC members.

Kara Escajeda stated that four people have requested membership at this time, Kris Long from TxDOT Waco District; Doug Edwards from Central Texas College; Marlene Maciborski from Women on Wheels and; Jimmie McCormack from Team Roadkill.

Mike Anderson made a motion to appoint Kris Long, Doug Edwards, Marlene Maciborski and Jimmie McCormack to BPAC; Robert Ator seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

6. Discussion and Possible Action Item: Regarding approval of the Vulnerable Road User Ordinance.

John Weber provided each BPAC member a copy of the Vulnerable Road User Ordinance. This ordinance provides a three foot buffer between road users and automobiles and may be used as a template for cities to create and enforce a Vulnerable Road User ordinance. If approved by BPAC, the ordinance will then go to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Transportation Planning Policy Board (TPPB) for their support. When TAC and TPPB support the ordinance, the Vulnerable Road User Ordinance will be sent out to the cities for their adoption if they so desire.

Brian Chandler made a motion to approve the Vulnerable Road User Ordinance; Kris Long seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

7. Presentation and Discussion Item: Temple Bike Share Program—Jennifer Graham, Temple College Foundation.

Jennifer Graham from Temple College Foundation gave a presentation about the Temple Bike Share Program. Ms. Graham discussed the operations, the purpose of Temple Bike Share, their goals and what they hope to accomplish.

8. Discussion Item: Bike Rack Identification and Need.

John Weber provided BPAC members bike racks options and asked for their feedback on what type of bicycle racks are preferred and best locations.

For bike racks, many BPAC members felt that the powder-coated, wave style bike racks are preferred due to easy installation and low maintenance. BPAC members identified park and rides, city parks, and transit stops as good locations for bike racks.

#### 9. Other Comments:

John Weber stated that Bike/Ped Web Map is currently down due to the account being updated to an organizational account. As soon as the upgrade is completed, the map will be published again.

#### Identify and Recommend Locations Where Bike Racks are Needed

At previous BPAC meetings, KTMPO asked BPAC members for their recommendations on what type of bike rack is preferred and where bike racks are needed. BPAC decided that the powder-coated, wavestyle bike racks were preferred because these racks are easy to install and can be easily maintained.

KTMPO staff is asking for a list of preferred locations in the KTMPO planning region (Bell County, Southern Coryell County, and Eastern Lampasas County) where bike racks are needed. This list will then go to the Central Texas Air Information and Research (CTAIR) Advisory Committee. CTAIR can then use BPAC recommendations to help determine locations for placing bike racks.
