Amendment to the FY17–20 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

TIP Background

The TIP is a 4-year transportation planning document that includes a detailed listing of projects reasonably expected to begin within a four year period. The current TIP covers FY17 through FY20. Projects included in the TIP must be consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and are chosen based on regional priority and available funding. An amendment to a TIP is not completed until the change has also been included in the STIP—Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.

The public involvement process for a TIP amendment includes a 15 day public comment period and a public hearing. A tentative schedule is outlined below.

Tentative Schedule:

- June 21, 2017—TPPB approval of initiation of PI process,
- June 24 – July 8, 2017 – 15 day public comment period;
- June 27, 2017 – Public Hearing, City of Killeen City Council Chambers (12:00pm), 101 N. College Street, Killeen, Texas 76541;
- July 5, 2017—TAC recommendation for approval of amendment;
- July 19, 2017—TPPB approval of amendment;

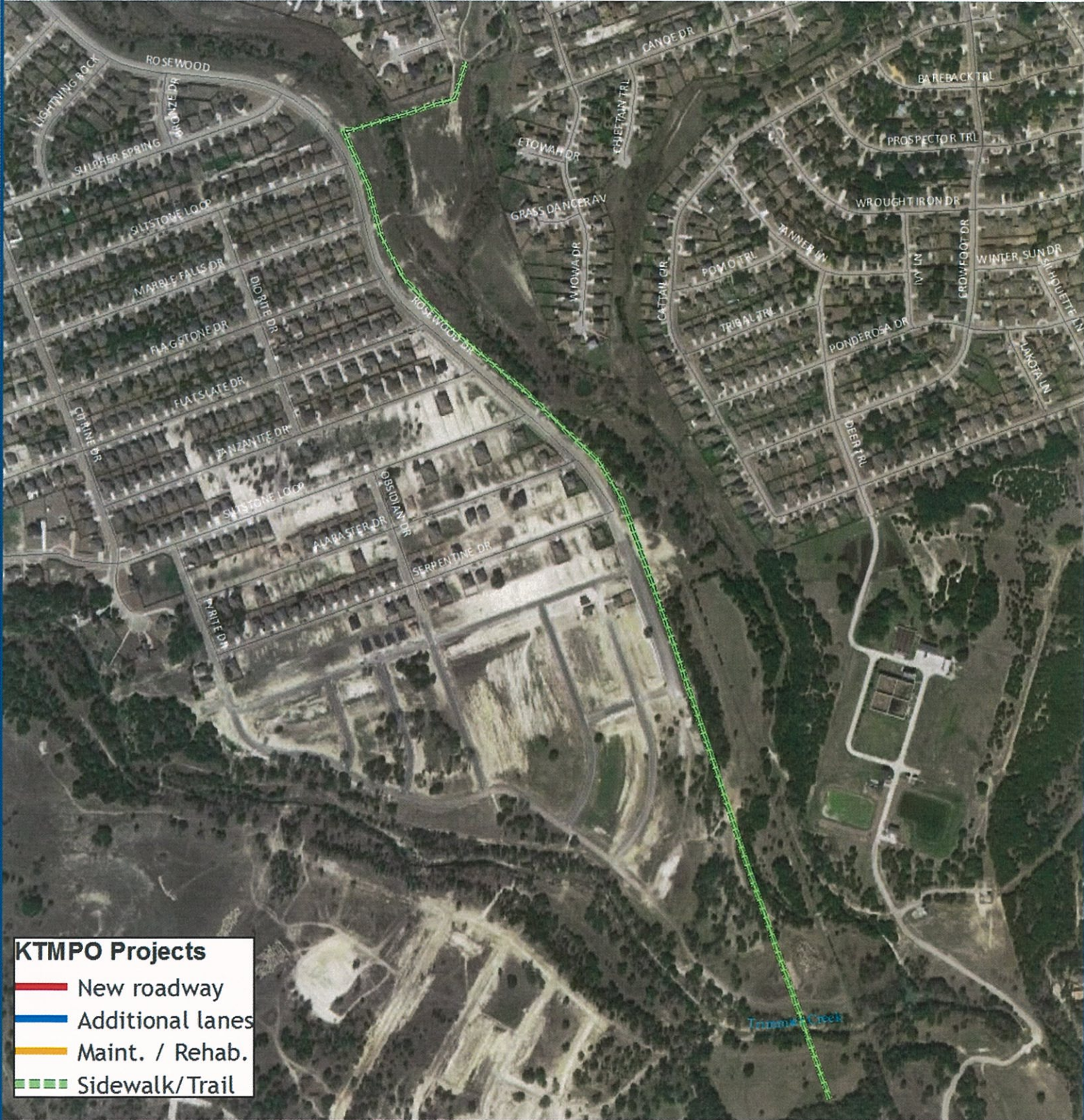
