Meeting Minutes

- 1. Call to Order:** Cheryl Maxwell called the meeting to order at 9:36 a.m.
- 2. Opportunity for Public Comment:** No comments were made from the public.
- 3. Staff Update:** KTMPO staff provided the following updates:
Cheryl Maxwell introduced Carter Thompson as the new CTCOG Planning and Regional Services Director.

Kendra Coufal provided an update on the Freight Advisory Committee (FAC) meeting on May 17, 2017. Ms. Coufal stated that TxDOT is holding a workshop in the Dallas area for the updated Texas Freight Mobility Plan. The next FAC meeting will be held on August 16, 2017 starting at 11:30 a.m.

John Weber provided an update on the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) meeting. The next BPAC meeting will be held on July 11 at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Weber stated that the Bike/Pedestrian Bus Tour has been rescheduled for Friday, June 9, 2017 starting at 8:30 a.m. At the May 9 BPAC meeting, BPAC members discussed issues that HCTD is facing when installing bike racks at transit stops. KTMPO is encouraging the cities to coordinate with HCTD for installing bicycle racks at the transit stops.

Ozone readings for the month of May were 75 parts per billion (ppb) at the Temple station and 69 ppb at the Killeen station.

Cheryl Maxwell stated that there was additional FY17 Category 7 funding. These funds were applied to the Killeen's Rosewood Project that was partially funded using FY15-17 funds since Policy Board authorized any additional funds to go to that specific project. The project is now fully funded.

4. Action Item: Approve minutes from May 3, 2017 meeting.

Dennis Baldwin made a motion to approve May 3, 2017 meeting minutes, seconded by Joseph Molis; the motion passed unanimously.

5. Action Item: Recommendation to approve the following amendments:

- a) 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) project listing to include transit projects updated project costs, division of projects into phases;
- b) FY17-20 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include project recommended for FY18-20 funding;
- c) FY16-17 Unified Planning Work Program to amend budget for FY17.

Cheryl Maxwell stated that a public comment period ran from May 20 through June 3 with a public hearing held on May 23, 2017 for the proposed amendments. KTMPO did not receive any comments during the public comment period. The MTP and TIP amendments were needed as a result of the projects selected for funding for FY18 – 20 Categories 2, 7, and 9 dollars. The UPWP amendment was needed to accommodate additional expenses to compile demographic and road network data for the travel demand model 2015 refresh since this was not included in the original budget for the FY16-17 UPWP.

Charlotte Hitchman made a motion to recommend approval of the 2040 MTP amendments, seconded by Erin Smith; the motion passed unanimously.

Joseph Molis made a motion to recommend approval of the FY17-20 TIP amendments, seconded by Lynn Barrett; the motion passed unanimously.

Charlotte Hitchman made a motion to recommend approval of the FY16-17 UPWP amendment, seconded by Erin Smith; the motion passed unanimously.

6. Action Item: Recommendation to approve Transit Performance Targets for State of Good Repair.

Kendra Coufal explained that HCTD established urban and rural performance targets under the Transit Asset Management (TAM) Final Rule. The Planning Rule requires KTMPO to establish targets no later than 180 days after the HCTD establishes its performance targets. The 180 day deadline is June 30, 2017. Ms. Coufal stated that KTMPO is proposing to adopt the urban and rural performance targets identified in the HCTD TAMP as the MPO performance targets for the region and any future revisions be administratively approved by KTMPO staff and presented to the TAC and TPPB.

Joseph Molis made a motion to adopt and establish HCTD State of Good Repair urban and rural system performance targets as the MPO performance targets for the region and authorize future revisions to be administratively approved by KTMPO staff, seconded by Lynn Barrett; the motion passed unanimously.

7. Discussion Item: Annual project call for MTP project listing.

Kendra Coufal stated that TAC and TPPB approved conducting an annual project call for adding projects to the MTP. Ms. Coufal explained that the 2045 MTP is due in May 2019 which will require a call for projects to occur in August/September 2018 and asked TAC members if they wanted to conduct a project call for 2017. The floor opened for discussion. TAC members decided that a project call in 2017 is not needed at this time.

8. Discussion Item: Public input received through May 31, 2017.

Kendra Coufal provided an update on the public input that KTMPO received through May 31, 2017.

9. Member Comments.

Carter Thompson stated the CTCOG will start offering assistance in writing comprehensive plans, zoning ordinance, overlay districts and other plans to cities within the CTCOG region. Ms. Thompson asked to notify her if there are any other services that CTCOG can look into.

Erin Smith stated that the City of Belton will be holding a workshop on June 7 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Harris Community Center to discuss the Belton’s Comprehensive Plan.

Joseph Molis stated that Harker Heights is looking into revitalizing Veterans Memorial Blvd.

Cheryl Maxwell stated that TxDOT will be hosting a public meeting on June 22 for US 190/I-14 at the Harris Community Center in Belton.

Liz Bullock stated that TxDOT will be holding a local government workshop on September 21, 2017.

10. Adjourn: The meeting adjourned at 10:17 a.m.

Amendment to the FY17 – 20 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Amendment Summary

An amendment to the FY17 – 20 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is requested to change the extent on Heritage Oaks Hike & Bike Trail Segment 3a (K40-23):

- Prior extent “Limits From: Flagstone Dr.,” “Limits To: Pyrite Dr.”
- Revised extent “Limits From: Nickelback Dr.,” “Limits To: Pyrite Dr.”

The public involvement process for a TIP amendment includes a public hearing and a 15 day public comment period. This amendment request was received after the June 7, 2017 TAC meeting; therefore, the opportunity was not available for TAC recommendation to initiate public involvement process for the amendment. The Policy Board approved initiation of the public involvement process for the FY17-20 TIP amendment at their June 21, 2017 meeting.

The 15 day public comment period runs from June 24-July 8, 2017 with a public hearing held on June 27, 2017. Public comments received to date will be presented at Wednesday’s meeting.

TIP Background

The TIP is a 4-year transportation planning document that includes a detailed listing of projects reasonably expected to begin within a four year period. The current TIP covers FY17 through FY20. Projects included in the TIP must be consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and are chosen based on regional priority and available funding. An amendment to a TIP is not completed until the change has also been included in the STIP—Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.

Tentative Schedule:

- June 21, 2017 – TPPB approval to initiate public involvement process for TIP amendment;
- June 24 – July 8, 2017 – 15 day public comment period;
- June 27, 2017 – Public Hearing, City of Killeen City Council Chambers, 101 N. College Street, Killeen, Texas 76541, 12:00 noon;
- July 5, 2017—TAC recommendation to approve TIP amendment;
- July 19, 2017—TPPB approval of TIP amendment.

Action Needed: Recommendation to approve amendment, subject to review of any comments received through end of the Public Comment period on July 8, 2017.
