**Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Call to Order:** Chair Mayor Marion Grayson called the meeting to order at 9:33 a.m.
- 2. Opportunity for Public Comment:** No comments were made from the public.
- 3. Staff Update:** KTMPO staff provided the following updates.

-- Cheryl Maxwell stated that there was additional FY17 Category 7 funding. These funds were applied to the Killeen Rosewood Project that was partially funded using FY15-17 funds since Policy Board authorized any additional funds to go to that specific project. The project is now fully funded.

--John Weber provided an update on the Freight Advisory Committee (FAC), Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) and air quality. The next FAC meeting will be held on August 16 at 11:30 a.m. KTMO had their first FAC meeting on May 17, 2017 which was attended by representatives from distribution and logistics companies, construction material and equipment haulers, ISDs, cities, Baylor Scott & White, Ft. Hood, TxDOT and Federal Highway Administration. The next BPAC meeting will be on July 11, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Weber provided an update on the BPAC project tour that occurred on June 9.

--Ozone readings for the month of April were 69 parts per billion (ppb) at the Killeen station and 75 ppb at the Temple station. Staff announced that FY18/19 funding for the air quality program through Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Rider 7 was vetoed by Governor Abbott; therefore, funds for the current program will terminate at the end of the year.

**4. Action Item:** Regarding approval of minutes from May 17, 2017 meeting.

**Vice Chair Mayor Frank Seffrood made a motion to approve May 17, 2017 meeting minutes, seconded by David Mitchell; the motion passed unanimously.**

**5. Action Item:** Regarding approval on the following amendments:

- a) 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan project listing to include transit projects, updated project costs, division of projects into phases;
- b) FY17-20 Transportation Improvement Program to include projects for FY18-20 funding;
- c) FY16-17 Unified Planning Work Program to amend budget for FY17.

Cheryl Maxwell stated that a 15 day public comment period was held on May 20 to June 3 with a public hearing held on May 23, 2017 for amendments to the 2040 MTP, FY17-20 TIP and FY16-17 UPWP. No comments were received at this time. Ms. Maxwell highlighted that two administrative changes were made to the TIP after the information packets went out for public comment. These changes include correcting the description for Belton Loop 121 (W40-04a) to widen from two to four lane divided roadway with bike/ped improvements and correcting the construction and total project cost for US 190 Clear Creek Turnaround (W40-03) to \$4,000,000 and \$4,601,000 respectively. The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) recommended approval of the proposed amendments at their June 7 meeting.

**Mayor Jose Segarra made a motion to approve the 2040 MTP, FY17-20 TIP, and FY 16-17 UPWP amendments as presented, seconded by Vice Chair Mayor Frank Seffrood; the motion passed unanimously.**

**6. Action Item:** Regarding approval to initiate public involvement process for the following amendment:

- a) FY17-20 Transportation Improvement Program to update limits for the Heritage Oaks Hike & Bike Trail Segment 3a (K40-23).

Cheryl Maxwell explained that an amendment to the FY17-20 TIP is needed to change the extent on Heritage Oaks Hike & Bike Trail Segment 3a (K40-23). The revised limits are from Nickelback Dr. to Pyrite Dr. Ms. Maxwell explained that the amendment request was received after the TAC meeting on June 7, 2017, therefore TAC did not have the opportunity to make a recommendation to initiate the public involvement process.

**David Mitchell made a motion to initiate the public involvement process for the FY17-20 TIP amendment, seconded by Councilmember Juan Rivera; the motion passed unanimously.**

**7. Action Item:** Regarding approval of Transit Performance Targets for State of Good Repair.

Cheryl Maxwell stated that Hill Country Transit District (HCTD) set performance targets for State of Good Repair for their Urban System in January this year, and just recently set targets for their Rural System. Therefore, KTMPO is moving forward to set transit performance targets for State of Good Repair for the region by the June 30, 2017 deadline.

Ms. Maxwell stated the MPO proposed to adopt the urban and rural performance targets identified in the HCTD Transit Asset Management Plan (TAMP) as the MPO targets for the region and that any future revisions be administratively approved by KTMPO staff and brought to the attention of TAC and TPPB. TAC recommended approval of the proposed action.

**Mayor Jose Segarra made a motion to adopt and establish the HCTD State of Good Repair urban and rural system performance targets in the TAMP as the MPO performance targets for the region and authorize future revisions to be administratively approved by KTMPO staff and presented to TAC and TPPB, seconded by Brian Chandler; the motion passed unanimously.**

**8. Discussion Item:** Annual project call for MTP project listing.

Cheryl Maxwell explained that a project call will occur in August/September 2018 since the 2045 MTP is due in May 2019, however, if deemed necessary, a project call may occur in 2017. Ms. Maxwell stated that this item was discussed at the June 7 TAC meeting and the consensus was to wait until the 2018 project call. TPPB agreed with waiting until 2018 to conduct a project call.

**9. Discussion Item:** Public input received through May 31, 2017.

John Weber provided TPPB with public input that KTMPO received during the month of May.

#### **10. Member Comments.**

Stan Swiatek was introduced as the new District Engineer for TxDOT Waco District.

**11. Adjourn:** The meeting adjourned at 9:59 a.m.

**Amendment to the FY17 – 20 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**

**Amendment Summary**

An amendment to the FY17 – 20 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is requested to change the extent on Heritage Oaks Hike & Bike Trail Segment 3a (K40-23):

- Prior extent “Limits From: Flagstone Dr.,” “Limits To: Pyrite Dr.”
- Revised extent “Limits From: Nickelback Dr.,” “Limits To: Pyrite Dr.”

The public involvement process for a TIP amendment includes a public hearing and a 15 day public comment period. This amendment request was received after the June 7, 2017 TAC meeting; therefore, the opportunity was not available for TAC recommendation to initiate public involvement process for the amendment. TAC recommended approval of the amendment subject to review of any comments received at their July 5, 2017 meeting. No further comments were received.

The 15 day public comment period ran from June 24-July 8, 2017 with a public hearing held on June 27, 2017. Public comments received are included in the meeting packet.

**TIP Background**

The TIP is a 4-year transportation planning document that includes a detailed listing of projects reasonably expected to begin within a four year period. The current TIP covers FY17 through FY20. Projects included in the TIP must be consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and are chosen based on regional priority and available funding. An amendment to a TIP is not completed until the change has also been included in the STIP—Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.

**Tentative Schedule:**

- June 21, 2017 – TPPB approval to initiate public involvement process for TIP amendment;
- June 24 – July 8, 2017 – 15 day public comment period;
- June 27, 2017 – Public Hearing, City of Killeen City Council Chambers, 101 N. College Street, Killeen, Texas 76541, 12:00 noon;
- July 5, 2017—TAC recommendation to approve TIP amendment;
- July 19, 2017—TPPB approval of TIP amendment.

**Action Needed:** Approval of FY17-20 TIP amendment to change the extent on Heritage Oaks Hike & Bike Trail Segment 3a (K40-23).

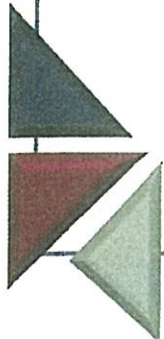

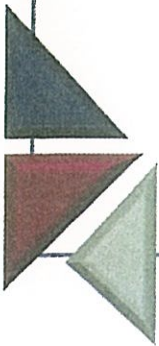

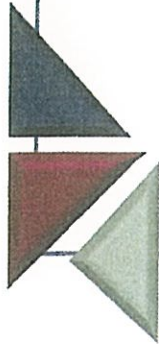
