Meeting Minutes:

- 1. Call to Order:** Uryan Nelson called the meeting to order at 9:35am.
- 2. Opportunity for Public Comment:** No comments were made by the public.
- 3. Staff Update:** Meeting Schedule; Other Updates; Air Quality.

Uryan Nelson reminded the TAC of upcoming KTMPO meetings through June and provided an update on the March TEMPO meeting. Mr. Nelson highlighted discussion on the proposed greenhouse gas measures and a recent federal court ruling delaying the enforcement of those rules. Mr. Nelson also provided an update on the AMPO Legislative Priorities and informed the TAC of the upcoming National AMPO

Conference in September. Additionally, Mr. Nelson shared several presentations from the March Texas Transportation Commission meeting on Eclipse Preparedness Presentation, an IH-35 improvements progress, and the 2060 Statewide Population Projections. The maximum ozone air quality readings for the month of March were 52 parts per billion (ppb) at the Temple station and 60 ppb at the Killeen station.

4. Action Item: Approve minutes from the March 6, 2024, meeting.

Bobbly Lewis made a motion to approve the March 6, 2024, meeting minutes, seconded by Mayra Cantu; the motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion and Action Item: Regarding recommending approval of Resolution 2024-05 recognizing May 2024 as National Bike Month.

Uryan Nelson presented Resolution 2024-05 recognizing May 2024 as National Bike Month. Mr. Nelson provided the TAC with the National Bike Month schedule.

Jason Deckman made a motion to recommend the approval of Resolution 2024-05 recognizing May 2024 as National Bike Month, seconded by Mayra Cantu; the motion passed unanimously.

6. Discussion and Action Item: Regarding 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan MTP Fiscal Constraints.

Uryan Nelson shared that all MTPs must be fiscally constrained for both short-range and long-range planning targets and provided an overview of how those constraints are determined using the 2050 UTP estimates and the TRENDS model. Mr. Nelson noted that historically, KTMPO has adopted the long-range medium constraints scenario, but that this round staff are recommending the adoption of the default scenarios. The floor opened for discussion.

Kendra Coufal and Mr. Nelson addressed questions and concerns from the TAC regarding the long-range fiscal constraint scenarios. Ultimately, the TAC decided to table the recommendation of the fiscal constraints until the May TAC meeting.

Jason Deckman made a motion to table recommending the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Fiscal Constraints until the May 2024 TAC meeting, seconded by Bobby Lewis; the motion passed unanimously.

7. Discussion Item: Regarding an update on the KTMPO 2050 MTP development.

Uryan Nelson provided an update on the KTMPO 2050 MTP development. Mr. Nelson informed the TAC staff are currently working on Chapters 2 and 5. Mr. Nelson stated that staff should have a draft for the TAC to review in the coming meetings.

8. Discussion Item: Regarding an update on the Safe Streets & Roads for All (SS4A) Grant.

Uryan Nelson updated the TAC on the SS4A Grant and the progress in in-kind matching. Additionally, Mr. Nelson shared details about the draft SS4A Project Listing created by consultants Kimley-Horn.

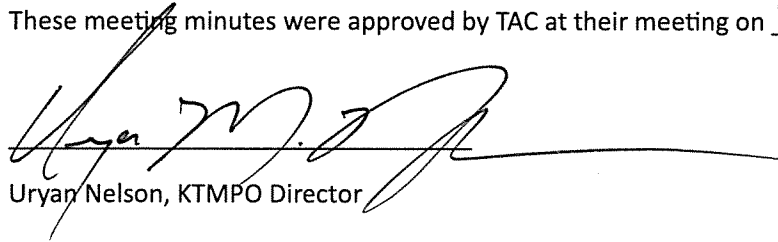
9. Discussion Item: Regarding public input received through March 2024.

Uryan Nelson updated the TAC on the public comments received through March, which were all related to HCTD's transition to a micro-transit system. The committee discussed these comments and focused their discussion on the strategies HCTD were implementing for public education and outreach to facilitate the transition to the new micro-transit system.
