Meeting Minutes:

1. **Call to Order:** Uryan Nelson called the meeting to order at 9:32am.
2. **Opportunity for Public Comment:** There were no public comments.
3. **Action Item:** Approve minutes from the March 11, 2026, meeting.

Robert Lewis made a motion to approve the March 11, 2026, meeting minutes, seconded by Darrell Burtner; the motion passed unanimously.

4. **Discussion and Action Item:** Regarding recommendation to approve Resolution 2026-05 recognizing May as National Bike Month.

Anita Janke, KTMPO Regional Planner, provided an overview of National Bike Month, including its background and significance, and highlighted the events that will be hosted in recognition of the occasion.

Tammy Cockrum made a motion to recommend approval of the Resolution 2026-05 recognizing May as National Bike Month, seconded by Kristina Ramirez; the motion passed unanimously.

5. **Discussion and Action Item:** Regarding recommendation to approve the Draft FY25 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Annual Report.

Uryan Nelson, KTMPO Director, provided an overview of the Draft FY25 TA Annual Report and explained its purpose.

Darrell Burtner made a motion to recommend approval of the Draft FY25 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Annual Report seconded by Robert Lewis; the motion passed unanimously.

6. **Discussion and Action Item:** Regarding approval of the Institute for Demographic and Socioeconomic Research (IDSER) UT San Antonio completion of Control Total Memo (CTM) for the KTMPO model planning area.

Kendra Coufal, KTMPO Senior Planner, provided an overview of the item and its purpose to the MPO. Po-Chung Huang, UTSA Special Research Associate, then delivered a presentation on the CTM and its methodology.

Robert Lewis made a motion to recommend approval of the Institute for Demographic and Socioeconomic Research (IDSER) UT San Antonio completion of Control Total Memo (CTM) for the KTMPO model planning area, seconded by Bob van Til; the motion passed unanimously.

7. **Discussion and Action Item:** Regarding recommendation to approve the Contract Agreement between KTMPO and Kimley-Horn for TDM Demographics and Network Update.

Kendra Coufal, KTMPO Senior Planner, provided an overview of the updated contract tasks and the revised total cost. A representative from Kimley Horn provided a brief overview of each task.

Bob van Til made a motion to recommend approval of the Contract Agreement

between KTMPO and Kimley-Horn for TDM Demographics and Network Update, seconded by Andrew Zagars; the motion passed unanimously.

8. **Discussion Item:** Regarding the Draft FY27-30 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

Callie Tullos, KTMPO Regional Planner, provided an overview of the Draft FY27–30 TIP, including updates and the addition of 18 highway projects and 28 transit projects. Anita Janke also provided an overview of past and upcoming public meetings.

9. **Discussion Item:** Regarding amendments to the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), FY27-30 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and Public Engagement Plan (PEP) related to Coordination and Consultation with Tribal Nations, Housing Stakeholders and the General Public for Other Planning Activities.

Kendra Coufal provided an overview of outreach efforts to Tribal Nations and housing stakeholders, including the associated activities and initiatives, and discussed how the MPO will include the general public in these outreach efforts.

10. **Discussion Item:** Regarding KTMPO request for Regionally Significant Projects to be included in transportation planning documents.

Callie Tullos informed the committee that KTMPO is requesting Regionally Significant Projects to be included in transportation planning documents.

11. **Discussion Item:** Regarding quarterly update on Transportation Grants.

Kendra Coufal provided a brief overview of upcoming transportation grants, highlighting that the FY2026 Safe Streets and Roads for All grant has recently opened.
