Meeting Minutes:

1. **Call to Order:** Kendra Coufal called the meeting to order at 9:34am.
2. **Opportunity for Public Comment:** There were no public comments.
3. **Action Item:** Approve minutes from the April 1, 2026, meeting.

Robert Lewis made a motion to approve the April 1, 2026, meeting minutes, seconded by Andrew Zagars; the motion passed unanimously.

4. **Discussion Item:** Regarding recommendation to approve the Draft Regional Active Transportation Plan (RATP).

Anita Janke, KTMPO Regional Planner, presented an overview of the Draft RATP, including information gathered from citizen surveys and feedback collected during the outreach process.

5. **Discussion and Action Item:** Regarding recommendation to approve the Draft FY27-30 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and amendments to the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and Public Engagement Plan (PEP).

Callie Tullos, KTMPO Regional Planner, provided an overview of the Draft FY27-30 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and amendments to the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). Anita Janke provided an overview of the amendments to the Public Engagement Plan (PEP).

6. **Discussion Item:** Regarding Tribal Historic Preservation in Transportation Planning.

Rebekah Dobrasko, TxDOT Director of the Cultural Resources Section, provided a presentation on TxDOT's role in historic preservation, tribal consultation, and compliance activities. Brad Jones, Texas Historical Commission Deputy State Historic Preservation Officer, provided a presentation on state preservation laws that are presented to tribes to help them better understand Texas state laws and how they intersect with tribal interests.

Robert Ramirez, TxDOT Planner, provided an overview of the purpose behind the Functional Classification Review. Mike Spayd with Garver USA provided an overview of the Functional Classification Assessment and TxDOT's response to the comments submitted by the TAC. Ashley Maggio with Garver USA reviewed the specific responses from KTMPO and provided additional detail regarding the final changes to the functional classifications.

8. **Discussion Item:** Regarding review of the 2025 Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) data.

Kendra Coufal, KTMPO Senior Planner, provided an update on the 2025 AADT data and encouraged the TAC to review the AADT for their planning areas and provide feedback through the GIS portal if revisions are needed.

9. **Discussion Item:** Regarding NHTSA Early Estimates for 2025 Traffic Fatalities.

Tay Floyd, KTMPO GIS Specialist, provided an update on NHTSA Early Estimates for 2025 Traffic Fatalities that KTMPO have received.

David Lopez, KTMPO Regional Planner, provided an update on the Speed Sign Loaner Program usage and encouraged the TAC to utilize the program for their jurisdictions.
